Other Ways to Use Your Tedderfield Zipper Top Playpen Mosquito Net

This net was designed to fit standard size playpens, but thanks to the drawstring base and zippers, it can be adapted to cover a multitude of other things.

Strollers: For any stroller, hold the net over the stroller and decide where you would like the zipper opening. Put the net over the stroller and pull the drawstring tight. Then, tuck the net in around the stroller. And, don't forget to tuck in the ends of the drawstring. 😊



- For the stroller pictured above, the zipper is positioned to make it easy to put your child into the stroller.
- After placing your child inside, you might find that the zipper blocks their view a little. Because there is plenty of room to manipulate the net, you can pull the net up so that the zipper rests on top of the stroller roof and does not block your child's view.
- To take your child out, pull the net down a bit so the zipper is in the right spot to unzip and you can easily take your child out.

For the stroller pictured below:



- The zipper is placed for easy access to your baby, and the stroller handle can fit through the zipper space. This way you can hold the handle for a better grip without the net covering it.
- The zipper is pulled tight around the handle. This leaves a small gap in the net, but it is unlikely that insects would fly through this gap.

You can also cover:

Basinets, cradles, car seats, or anything else that can fit into the dimensions of L40.5" x W29.5" x H32.5".

Steps:

- Position the zipper conveniently for opening and closing,
- Pull the drawstring tight,
- Tuck any excess net in and tuck in the drawstring ends.

Note: You may have to position the net with the zipper in a certain spot for opening and closing and then move the zipper part of the net a bit so it does not block your child's view.

When using the net with a playpen, we strongly recommend...

Pull the base drawstring tight and tuck the net under the playpen wheels/feet. (Also tuck the ends of the drawstring under the playpen.)

If you tuck the net under the playpen wheels/feet so that the top pulls tight, it should be strong enough to prevent small toys or balls from landing on your child should someone happen to toss them their way.

Also, with the net secured this way, your child should not be able to pull the net into the playpen.
